Driving Directions

From the East – NEW YORK/NORTH JERSEY

1. Drive West on I-80 towards the Delaware Water Gap.
2. Continue through the Water Gap towards I-380.
3. Merge onto I-380 N via **EXIT 293** toward SCRANTON
4. Merge onto I-81 North toward BINGHAMTON to **EXIT 223**.
5. Take the PA-492 West (turn left) toward MONTROSE/NEW MILFORD.
6. Turn LEFT onto MAIN ST/US-11. Continue to follow US-11.
7. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto PA-706 W.
8. Continue onto PA-706 (SLIGHT LEFT)
9. Turn RIGHT onto LOCUST ST.
10. Turn RIGHT onto LAKE DRIVE; continue for three blocks until you come to CAMP MONTROSE (Youth Campus) on Left.

From the CENTRAL NEW JERSEY

1. Drive West on I-78 (Crossing into PENNSYLVANIA).
2. Merge onto PA-33 N via EXIT 71 toward US-STROUDSBURG.
3. Merge onto I-80 W via the exit on the LEFT toward HAZLETON. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS FROM #3 ABOVE

From the SOUTH – PHILADELPHIA REGION

1. Drive North on I-476 (from Philadelphia area) or I-81 (from Harrisburg area).
2. At the junction of I-476 and I-81, proceed North on I-81 to **Exit 223**.
3. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS FROM #5 ABOVE

From the SOUTH – TRENTON

1. Drive South on US 1 towards Morrisville/Philadelphia (crossing over into Pennsylvania).
2. Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike exit, merging into I-276 West towards Harrisburg.
3. Merge into I-476 North towards Allentown
4. Follow directions from **SOUTH-PHILADELPHIA REGION**
