### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

To ensure that the Overflow Family Retreat sponsored by the Word of Life Apostolic Center, Inc., is a positive and enjoyable experience to all participants, it is necessary to establish and enforce high standards of behavior. This Family Retreat is solely operated as a <a href="CHRISTIAN">CHRISTIAN</a> event, and all rules are to help us in our conduct to reflect Jesus Christ in all that we do.



- All campers must comply with the CDC guidelines on preventing the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
- All campers must agree to having their body temperature taken at random intervals, upon enter the campsite facilities, and before camp activities.
- All campers will be courteous and respectful towards others at all times.
- All campers must agree to value and respect others' ideas regardless of whether they are the same as my own.
- All campers must respect authority and comply with the requests of the facilitators, directors, counselors, chaperones, event personnel, instructors, camp security at all times.
- All campers will take full responsibility for any damage to personal or public property due to their own actions.
- All campers will actively participate in all sessions and activities during scheduled events.
- All campers will conduct themselves in a decent and Christian manner at all times.
- Discrimination of any type will not be tolerated.
- Campers will not engage in any behavior of a sexual nature at any time during this event.
- All campers are required to attend all sessions unless excused by camp director.

Violation to this code of conduct will result in immediate dismissal from the Camp, and this camper will be sent home at their own expense. Parents camping with children under 4 years will be required to take full responsibility of their child/children for the entire duration of the event.

### **CAMP RULES**

- 1. All Campers eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine (as stipulated by the CDC) must be vaccinated to attend OFR2021.
- 2. Camp Identification (ID) Badges must be worn at all times.
- 3. Punctual attendance is expected at all camp activities, unless excused by Camp Director.
- 4. Personal conduct of all campers should be that of high ideals in speech, behavior, and attire. Foul language and lewd/immodest attire will not be permitted.
- 5. Prohibited items include:
  - a. Tobacco in any form, or electronic cigarettes.
  - b. Fireworks, matches, lighters, guns, knives, guns or weapons of any kind.
- 6. Alcohol or drugs (prescription medication in original package will be allowed, only if indicated on the registration form).
- 7. No one is to leave the campus unless authorized by the camp director.
- 8. The dress code for the Overflow Retreat is, 'Modest Casual Attire', campers must dress modestly at all times.
  - a. No T-shirts will questionable pictures or words/sayings allowed.
  - b. A T-shirt or other cover-up must be worn over swim suits.
  - c. Male campers should wear tops at all times.
  - d. Male campers must have their trousers/pants securely fastened to waist. No baggy/sagging pants are allowed.
  - e. Robes should be worn to and from shared showers at all times.
- 9. Each camper is responsible for his/her own belongings. Borrowing is discouraged. Please put nametags in clothing.
- 10. No camper is allowed to independently change dormitory assignment. All changes must be approved by camp office.
- 11. Males are not permitted to enter female dormitories under any circumstances, and females are not permitted to enter male dormitories under any circumstances.
- 12. TVs, electronic games are not allowed at camp. Mobile devices are brought to campsite at the camper's discretion, and Word of Life Apostolic Center will not be held liable for damages or theft. It is the responsibility of each camper to secure any mobile devices brought to the campsite.
- 13. All cellular phones should be in the vibrate mode at all times, and usage are not allowed during sessions.
- 14. There is no place in camp for "rough housing" or practical jokes, which, though not intended, can result in injury or property damage.
- 15. Campers are expected to keep themselves clean and observe the rules of personal hygiene.
- 16. Campers are subject to direction and correction by any staff member
- 17. Meals must be eaten in the Dining Hall unless otherwise prearranged with the Camp Director. NO FOOD IS PERMITTED IN THE DORMITORIES/ROOMS.
- 18. Public Display of Affection (PDA) will not be tolerated.
- 19. Shaving cream fights, water balloon fights, etc. will not be tolerated in any building. A person/group doing such in or near a building and causes damage will have to pay to have damages fixed.
- 20. Stewardship of camp property is important. The campsite must be left in as good or better shape than is was found upon arrival.
